

Mitch and I are part of the Outreach program at Packerland Kennel Club. Mitch is half Labrador Retriever and half Golden Retriever. He is the 16th puppy I raised for Leader Dogs For The Blind. I got Mitch when he was 7 weeks old and worked with him until he was 14 months old. He then returned to Leader Dog for the next step of his training as a guide dog. The school evaluated him as a 10, which is the highest score a dog can get. But Mitch did not want be a guide dog, and I was fortunate to get him back, which made me very happy because I was rather fond of him. Since Mitch had such a great personality and got along so well with other dogs and animals I felt that this gentle nature of his should be used in some other way. We then began the process of becoming a registered Therapy Dog, which was Mitch's true calling. He makes me so proud every time we do the Outreach events. Mitch is known as the 'belly rub dog' in the group and he makes so many people smile and laugh. The Outreach program has great people and dogs in the group and they all touch the hearts and souls of so many in this community.



AUGUST TRIAL EQUIPMENT MOVE

The August Agility Trial is fast approaching. On **Thursday**, **August 3rd at 6 p.m.** we will be moving agility equipment from the Brown County Fairgrounds to the Cornerstone Community Ice Center. Once you have helped load, then drive to Cornerstone to meet the truck to help unload, please. There will be refreshments at both the Fairgrounds and Cornerstone. (Remember, sections of Ashland Avenue are under construction.) **We will meet at the Fairgrounds at 6 p.m. Thank you for your help.**

We will also need volunteers to move the equipment back to the PKC building and storage facility on **Sunday**, **August 6th**, after the trial is completed. The trial should end between **2:30 and 3 p.m.** We now have a bigger storage shed, too, which is closer to Cornerstone. The new shed is located behind the businesses on Packerland Drive, near the Hotel J.

Please take time to help with these moves. The time you spend helping will be counted toward your volunteer hours. For your convenience, there will be Volunteer Hours sheets available at Cornerstone for you to pick up. Complete this form and drop it off at the Club building before November 2017 to receive credit. The more people we have the faster we get done!

P.S. Also on **Thursday**, **August 3rd at 10 a.m.**, we need to pack up the mats at the fairgrounds. This entails moving the equipment off the mats, vacuuming the mats, 'tearing' them apart, then stacking them on pallets. The mats get moved early to Cornerstone so the volunteers can start laying them down and be ready when the equipment arrives after 6 p.m. In June, it did take about 4 hours to lay them down; it is a big job. We would greatly appreciate the help from anyone available to help with this portion of the move.
