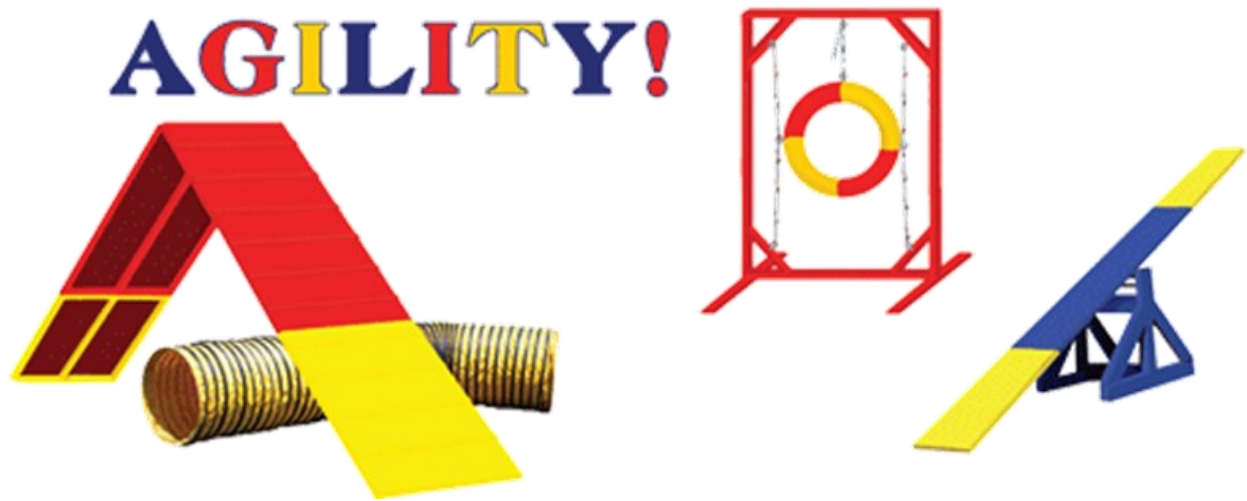
By laws. Motion carried.
