Discussed reminders regarding orientation:

Dogs are preferred to not attend orientation.

Bring fecal exam results, payment and vaccination record.

If the documents or payment are missing when the sessions begin, the members are allowed to stay in the building to watch the class.

Kennel Club computer is not working. Board members approved Derek to take the computer home and attempt fixing it.
