* Oct. 2 is a Business Meeting night and will affect the training schedule.

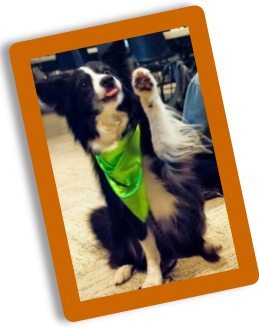

In and Around PKC

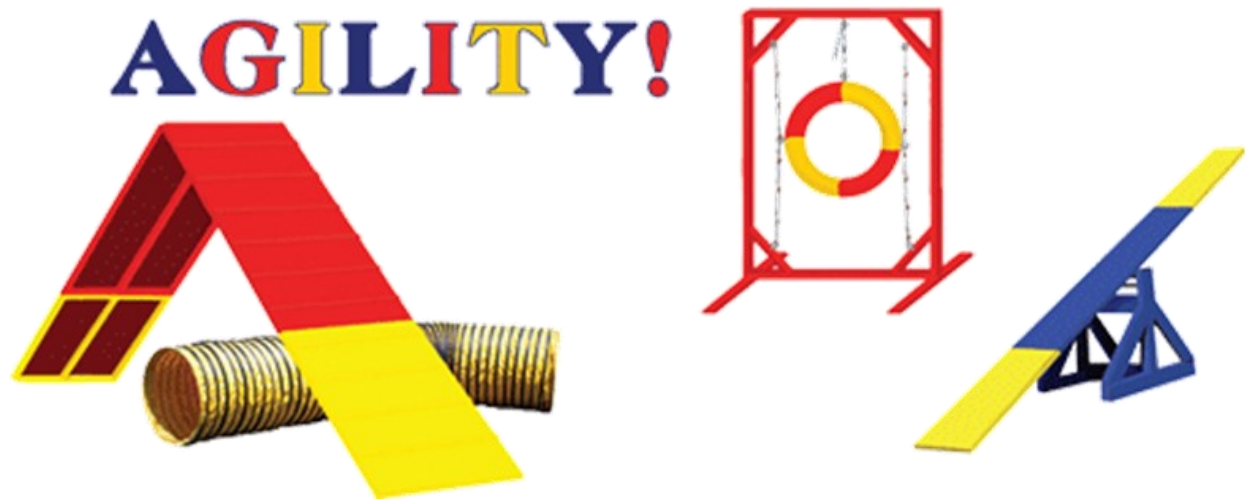

Volunteer Opportunities

Just a quick reminder that Packerland Kennel Club's agility trial is August 2 – 4, 2019 at the Cornerstone Ice Arena in De Pere. And we need volunteers! This is PKC's final big event of the year and your help is needed to make it successful.

Equipment move is Thursday, August 1st. Meet at the Brown County Fairgrounds at 6 p.m. to help load the truck that will then go to the Cornerstone Ice Arena. Once the truck is loaded, please go to Cornerstone to meet the truck to help unload.

Help is needed moving equipment, after the completion of the agility trial on Sunday August 4th, to the PKC building and the storage unit. Estimated time of trial completion is 3:30 p.m. This project entails picking up the mats and placing on the pallets. If you cannot do heavy lifting, we do need someone to vacuum or sweep around the rink, behind the boards, and the hallway between the rink and outside.
