CURRENT VERBIAGE REGARDING CLUB MEMBERSHIPS

## ARTICLE I - MEMBERSHIP

## SECTION 1. Eligibility

a. There shall be two types of membership open to all persons eighteen years of age and older who are in good standing with the American Kennel Club and who subscribe to the purposes of this Club. The family membership consists of husband and wife, and a single membership is for persons who are not married or are legally separated.

## SUGGESTED CHANGE TO TYPE OF MEMBERSHIPS; EXPANDING ON THE CURRENT TWO TYPES. <br> Revised as a result of the October 2, 2019 Packerland KC, Inc. meeting

## ARTICLE I - MEMBERSHIP

## SECTION 1. Eligibility

There shall be four types of membership open to persons who are in good standing with The American Kennel Club and who subscribe to the purposes of this Club and who meet the specific qualifications of the class of membership required as follows.
a) Household Membership. A household membership shall be issued to not more than two individuals 18 years of age or older residing at the same address. The two adult individuals shall have all the privileges of the Club. Household membership carries two votes (one vote per person).
b) Regular (Individual) Membership. A regular membership shall be issued to an individual 18 years or older and shall have all the rights and privileges of the club and has one vote.
c) Junior Membership. A junior membership shall be issued to an individual under the age of 18 years actively participating in the sport of dogs. Junior members shall have all the rights and privileges of regular membership except the right to vote or hold office. A junior membership may be converted to a regular (individual) membership upon reaching 18 years of age. A junior member must have available a parent or guardian to sign their application for membership.
d) Associate Membership. An associate membership shall be issued to an individual who lives outside of the Club's area and/or to an individual who lives in the Club's area, but not active in the Club. Individuals holding an associate membership cannot train, (therefore, are exempt from the volunteer criteria), cannot vote or hold an office, but can receive the Club's newsletter.

If an individual decides to come back to train at the Club, this individual has forfeited their Associate Membership. Their membership changes to a Regular (Individual) membership, and thus must pay the membership fee. This conversion is a complete conversion (refer to Eligibility, part b) for more details.

## ARTICLE III - DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS

## SECTION 2. OFFICERS

f. No officer shall serve in the same capacity for more than two consecutive terms, the with exception of the Training Directors.

## ARTICLE IV - THE CLUB YEAR, ANNUAL MEETING and ELECTION <br> SECTION 3. ELECTIONS

b. The Board of Directors shall be elected as follows:
(1) Three (3) Board members shall be elected for a two-year period.
(2) At each subsequent election, three (3) Board members shall be elected for a two-year period.

ARTICLE III - DIRECTORS AND OFFICERS
SECTION 2. OFFICERS
f. Club officers shall not serve, in the same capacity for more than two consecutive terms, unless the Nomination Committee is unable to find a candidate for any of the open officer positions and there are no nominations from the floor.

Board members shall not serve more than two consecutive two-year terms, unless the Nomination Committee is unable to find enough candidates for the available positions and there are no nominations from the floor.

#### Abstract

AWARD GUIDELINES To claim a merit award, a title must have been earned between January 1 and December 31, 2019. If you think your dog has finished a title, but haven't received notification, call AKC to verify your points and/or legs to meet the DEADLINE (January 15, 2020). Club policy gives one (1) merit award for an individual dog for each title earned to the owner (co-owners may purchase a duplicate award from PKC if they are members in good standing with the Club).

To request an award, the owner of the dog must be a member in good standing (not a trainee) and the dog must live primarily with the club member requesting the award. Only one plaque per dog will be awarded. The owner of the dog must have completed the required volunteer hours during the year or pay a $\$ 25.00$ fee to PKC. Please submit one Merit Award form per dog regardless of the number of titles earned. Only AKC titles and titles recognized by AKC (accompanied with an AKC title certificate) will be awarded by PKC (including CGC and CGCA). Additional title plates for titles that are awarded by other clubs (other than AKC, including single breed parent clubs) may be purchased by the owner. (For awards other than from AKC, black title plates are $\$ 5.20$ each and gold plates are $\$ 6.50$ each.) The dog must earn an AKC title to be awarded the initial awards plaque by PKC. Only one MACH/PACH/PAX award plaque will be awarded per dog. Additional poles will be added to the plaque as the dog accumulates multiple agility championships. No awards will be given retroactively. THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS-THIS APPLICATION MUST BE TURNED IN NO LATER THAN THE DEADLINE STATED ON THIS FORM! THE FORM MAY BE MAILED TO CAROL LIEBL, 1524 WEISE STREET, GREEN BAY, WI 54302 OR BROUGHT TO THE PKC OFFICE.
