## ARTICLE I - MEMBERSHIP

## SECTION 1. Eligibility

& \text { who subscribe to the purposes of this Club. The family membership } \\
& \text { consists of husband and wife, and a single membership is for persons who } \\
& \text { are not married or are legally separated. }
\end{aligned}

## SUGGESTED CHANGE TO TYPE OF MEMBERSHIPS; EXPANDING ON THE CURRENT TWO TYPES.

## ARTICLE I - MEMBERSHIP

SECTION 1. Eligibility
There shall be four types of membership open to persons who are in good standing with The American Kennel Club and who subscribe to the purposes of this Club and who meet the specific qualifications of the class of membership required as follows.
a) Household Membership. A household membership shall be issued to not more than two individuals 18 years of age or older residing at the same address. Any child (ren) in the household aged 9-17 may be added for an additional fee per child (if one child or each child will be handling a dog in a class). The two adult individuals shall have all privileges of the Club. Household membership carries two votes (one vote per person).
b) Regular (Individual) Membership. A regular membership shall be issued to an individual 18 years or older, who is single, and shall have all the rights and privileges of the club and has one vote.
c) Junior Membership. A junior membership shall be issued to an individual under the age of 18 years actively participating in the sport of dogs. Junior members shall have all the rights and privileges of regular membership except the right to vote or hold office. A junior membership may be converted to a regular (individual) membership upon reaching 18 years of age. A junior member must have available a parent or guardian to sign their application for membership and abide by the Club's rules for children under the age of 18 while the child (ren) is (are) handling a dog on the training floor in a class.
d) Associate Membership. An associate membership shall be issued to an individual who lives outside of the Club's area and/or to an individual who lives in the Club's area, but not active in the Club. Individuals holding an associate membership cannot train, (therefore, are exempt from the volunteer criteria), cannot vote or hold an office, but can receive the Club's newsletter.

If an individual decides to come back to train at the Club, this individual has forfeited their Associate Membership. Their membership changes to a Regular (Individual) membership, and thus must pay the membership fee. This conversion is a complete conversion (refer to Eligibility, part b) for more details.

Packerland Kennel Club's Board has voted to approve the following proposed changes to the Club's BY-LAWS.

Reasons for changes:

* The American Kennel Club has changed their definition of marriage and defines what they consider who can be included in an immediate family.
* PKC has been challenged multiple times on why a person has to pay family membership rate when the spouse has no interest in training a dog at the Club. The change is more specific to assist with these situations.
* Adding membership classifications for those members who are not active but still appreciate some news of the Club. But, then to define ' what happens next' when an inactive member wishes to become an active member.
* Looking to the future: encouraging those younger dog lovers out there to become active and involved with Club activities and specifically involved in the Sport of Dogs! if their parents are not equally interested.

## SECTION 3. ELECTIONS

b. The Board of Directors shall be elected as follows:
(1) Three (3) Board members shall be elected for a two-year period.
(2) At each subsequent election, three (3) Board members shall be elected for a two-year period.
