

Rules to sign up for wejoin

Trainers Assistants and Directors.

Must teach at least three sessions a year to be eligible. FYI If there are not enough students for a class that is offered that session the trainers and assistants still get credit.

May train 3 hours per week.

Current trainers may sign up on Monday for the following week at 9am.

Trainers not teaching the current session can sign up on Wednesday for the following week and only get one hour per week if the three sessions are not met.

No charge to use the floor.

Board Members

May train 2 hours per week.

May sign up on Monday for the following week.

No charge to use the floor.

Club Members

Must have completed 2 years of volunteer hours. Example those eligible in 2024 must be members prior to 2021 and volunteer hours completed.

May train up to one hour a week

May sign up on Wednesday for the following week.

Cost is \$5 per half hour of floor time. There will be envelopes available to put your name on with funds and put in the treasurer's box.

All people who use the floor.

You must give at least a twenty-four-hour notice if you are not going to use the sign up time. Those that abuse this will lose sign up privileges.

Payment is required for use of the floor if you sign up and don't show for your scheduled time. Failure to do this will result in loss of sign up privileges.

All equipment used must be put away where you found it prior to the end of your sign up time.

Non members are required to pay even if they show up with a member to use the floor. The cost for non members with members is \$10 per half hour. All visitors must sign a waiver.

Everyone who uses the floor needs to sign up on we join and the sign up sheet at the club.

No agility equipment can be used until Keith comes up with agility rules.

When in the building the front door must be unlocked (don't forget to lock in when you leave).

Use of Agility Equipment

Any use of the Agility Equipment requires knowledge of the equipment, in order to use it safely for both the handler and dog. For this reason, the following rules of use have been developed.

USE OF ALL AGILITY EQUIPMENT, INCLUDING CONTACTS

1. Anyone currently teaching or has taught Agility Classes
2. Anyone currently or has competed in Agility

Note: As a reminder some of the contacts are heavy and awkward and require two people to set up.

USE OF JUMPS, TUNNELS, AND WEAVE POLES

1. Anyone currently taking Agility Classes

CLEANING OF EQUIPMENT

1. Anyone using the equipment must clean any spills or accidents that may occur on the equipment. (i.e. If your dog urinates or has a bowl movement in a tunnel it must be cleaned immediately.)
