A demo at an assisted living facility on the east side of Green Bay will be held on Thursday, September 21 at 10 a.m. This will be outdoors with no fencing.


A demo at a senior living community in Luxemburg on Wednesday, September 27 at 10 a.m.

~ Journal of a Trial Chair ~

The August Agility Trial is now finished and in the books; a whirlwind of much planning, implementation, execution and completion. It all started several weeks before the trial. Entries were gathered and processed by Kathy Dachlet. Sandy Dunand contacted the caterer and ordered the food. Keith Rosin made sure the 26-foot truck with a lift gate was 'on order'.

During the week before the trial, non-perishable foods, soda and water were purchased, and keys were picked up from the Cornerstone Ice Center. Organization was started in the PKC kitchen which served as the staging area for the food service at Cornerstone. The big tote was packed with any item that any kitchen would need. Candee Brey helped transport the soda, water, easel, big tote, etc. to the show site. Plus, the food service area was arranged for serving with the coolers loaded with soda and water for volunteers starting Thursday evening.

At the fairgrounds, the Wednesday evening classes were combined into one. All members in attendance stayed to help move equipment off the flooring, vacuum and tear up the mats and place them on the pallets to make ready for the move on Thursday.

Early Thursday morning, Mary Scott, Sandy and I met at the show site to place the tables in the area for Kathy and the judge, and trophy area. Mary and Sandy stayed at the show site, while I drove to the fairgrounds to help Keith load the mats into the truck, as this was a complete move to a new storage facility, a few extra items had to be loaded also from the Club building. Bree Draves met Keith at the show site and they unloaded the mats for the trial floor. Then they went back to the fairgrounds and got the mats that would go to the storage unit. The floor for the trial could now be laid. Throughout the afternoon, a few more people arrived to help with the floor.

At 6 p.m. Keith met more Club members at the fairgrounds to load the truck for the third and last time before the trial. Shortly before the truck came back, the floor was completed. Several Club members were there to help unload the equipment, place the gating around the ring and make ready for Friday, Day 1 of the trial.

During the trial days of Friday through Sunday, PKC members were joined by many non-members to help as ring crew, scribes, timers, leash and sheet runners and gate stewards. Janet Gomez helped Kathy to post scores, and delivered paperwork to the ring for each class. Jan & Kerry Tesch came early to work as chief course builders for Friday and assist Dave Dachlet the remainder of the weekend to build courses. Mary was joined by Carol Liebl to line up the placement ribbons, MACH poles, QQ gifts, etc. that were given away to all successful dog/handler teams during the 3-day trial. Sandy, now acting as volunteer coordinator, made sure all the positions were filled inside and outside the ring per class per day.

Saturday morning, the caterer delivered the food at 7:30 a.m. Members take turns with the prep, serving and clean-up during both days of the trial. Food is always available to any of those volunteers who assisted during the trial, plus it is available for sale to those who came to watch the dogs run the courses. By offering a free meal to the volunteers it is one small way to thank those people who helped during those two days of the trial.

Once the trial was completed, the equipment was moved into the truck, part of which was taken to storage and part to the Club building for fall/winter classes. The floor was picked up with Wendee Draves and Mary leading the way with the mats. The mats were loaded onto eight pallets. The food prep area was cleaned up, tables and chairs borrowed from Cornerstone were returned to their areas, equipment and signs were collected and trash disposed of. Once the floor mats were on pallets, the floor was swept free of dog hair and the lobby was vacuumed. By the time the rink was cleaned up, most of the members had gone home after the long weekend. I stayed behind to wait for the truck to come back to pick up the mats - the final load of the weekend. Mats were loaded, then unloaded at the storage unit. Truck was returned. Weekend done!!

Many, many Club members contributed to all aspects of the trial weekend. I hesitate to list all the names, as I am afraid to miss anyone. But, please know that I extend my heartfelt IHANK YOU to all volunteers that made this trial successful and run smoothly! I appreciate you all!!


